- Age is determined as of Jan 1st
- You may enter 9&Under w/t OR w/t/c
- Classes with limited entries may be run concurrently but judged separately
- *Not nationally pointed classes
- National POA Club rules will prevail

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

1. Club Membership
 - a. Send a separate payment with the description "Club Membership" and list the names included on the membership through Venmo to @Utah-POAC
 - b. Cost
 - i. \$45 per immediate family
 - ii. \$25 single participate
2. Entry Due Dates
 - a. Entries are due by midnight the Thursday before each show.
3. High Point Requirements
 - a. Must be a Utah POA Club member
 - b. All-Around High Point
 - i. To qualify for any highpoint you must attend 3 of the 4 pointed shows (practice or clinics do not count).
 - ii. Compete in 3 out of 4 divisions. The divisions include:
 1. English (classes 1-25)
 2. Halter (classes 26-39 except for class 34, most colorful)
 3. Western (classes 40-73)
 4. Games (classes 74-96)
 - iii. Same horse/same rider
 - c. Division High Points
 - i. Compete in the same division(s) 3 out of the 4 shows
 - ii. Points are calculated per rider, not horse/rider combo
 1. If riding multiple horses in same events, you must designate which horse to get highpoint points with prior to the start of the show
4. Participation Award
 - a. To qualify for participation award a rider must have competed in 2 of the 4 pointed shows
5. High Points Awards (See High Point Guides Below)
 - a. All-Around High Point and Reserve High Point per age group
 - b. Division High Point and Reserve per age group
 - c. Triad 2 & Under & Triad Open
6. Quick info for day of show
 - a. The club can make adjustments to the show by combining classes, turning patterned classes into rail classes or other adjustments to fit the needs of the show. This may also include running trail concurrently.
 - b. Helmets must be worn in English, jumping, and games.
 - c. Western attire is required for games
 - d. First and second place halter class winners will return for championship classes.
 - e. Age is determined as of Jan 1st
 - f. You may enter 9&Under w/t OR w/t/c
 - g. Hunt Seat Eq. & Western Horsemanship is a patterned class unless otherwise notified.
 - h. An entry cannot show in walk trot class AND three gait classes in the same category. (ex: If your rider shows in Western Pleasure 14-18 then may not show in Western Pleasure 18 & Under W/T. Please see the high point guides below.)
 - i. Classes with limited entries may be run concurrently but judged separately
 - j. National POA Club rules will prevail
 - k. Please see [rule book](#) for tack and attire rules
7. Age divisions and multiple horse & rider combos
 - a. A rider cannot show in walk trot classes AND three gait classes at the same show
 - b. You may enter 9&Under w/t OR w/t/c
 - c. An entry cannot show in walk trot class AND three gait classes in the same category.
 - d. If a POA is shown by multiple riders in different age groups, national points must be designated before the show starts.
